

WINTERGREEN BOXWOOD

Buxus microphylla 'Koreana'

Height: 2-3' **Spread:** 2-3'

Location: Zone 4, sun to part shade

Shape: Compact, upright

Foliage: Bright green, bronze in fall/winter

Notes: This Korean boxwood cultivar is a dense, compact, many-branched, broad, mounded evergreen shrub which usually has a loose and open habit. Slow annual growth (to 2" in height per year), however height may obviously be controlled by pruning. An extremely hardy plant that is a good choice for northern climates. Fragrant flowers in April.
