

CHARLES JOLY LILAC

Syringa vulgaris 'Charles Joly'

Height: 8-12' **Spread:** 8-10'

Location: Zone 3, full sun

Shape: Upright, rounded, non-suckering

Foliage: Green

Notes: One of the earlier French hybrids, this lilac is still popular. It bears smaller panicles of purple buds that turn to magenta double flowers as they open for a fabulous show!



COMMON PURPLE LILAC

Syringa vulgaris

Height: 12-15' **Spread:** 8-12'

Location: Zone 2, sun

Shape: Upright, vase-like, suckering

Foliage: Blue-green

Notes: This old-fashioned Lilac is the one most of us remember from our youth. A perfect informal hedge or screen, it has extremely fragrant, purple flowers in May. Color may vary from purple to lilac. The cut flowers hold up very well, and easily fill a house with their fragrance.
